LIMITATION OF REMEDIES (SCIENTIFIC AND RESEARCH PROJECTS)  
1965-61

*An Act to limit the remedies available to plaintiffs in proceedings seeking relief in respect of the acts or omissions, or the threatened or apprehended acts or omissions, of persons engaged in the execution of any approved scientific or research project.*

[Commencement: 16th December, 1965]

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Limitation of Remedies (Scientific and Research Projects) Act*.

**Interpretation**

2. For the purposes of this Act, the expression  
“actions” includes any civil proceedings howsoever commenced;  
“court” includes any court or judge having the jurisdiction, power or authority to grant an injunction;  
“injunction” means any interim or perpetual injunction.

**Limitation of remedies**

3.(1) Notwithstanding any provision or rule of law to the contrary, no court shall, in any proceedings to which this Act applies

- (a) grant any injunction; or
- (b) make any declaratory order or judgment; or
- (c) grant any other relief or remedy save damages.

(2) The proceedings to which this Act applies are actions (whether or not commenced before the 16th December, 1965\*) against any person in respect of any act or omission, or any threatened or apprehended act or omission, of any person in the course of the execution of any scientific or research project set out in the Schedule.

*\*[Being the date of commencement of this Act.]*

(3) The Minister may, by order published in the *Official Gazette*, amend the Schedule by the addition thereto, or the deletion therefrom, of any scientific or research project.
