**BARBADOS****ROAD ABANDONMENT  
1977-10**

*An Act to provide for the abandonment of the rights of way and other rights of the public affecting a part of Enterprise Road, a public road in the parish of Christ Church, and for the dedication to the use of the public of an alternative road.*

[Commencement: 23rd May, 1977]

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Abandonment Act.

**Abandonment of road**

2. As from the 18th April, 1974 all rights of way and other rights of the public affecting Enterprise Road in the parish of Christ Church from its junction with Highway 7 at Oistins in that parish for a distance of 810 feet shall be deemed to have been abandoned and to have ceased and determined.

**Dedication to public of certain lands for use as road**

3. As from the commencement of this Act the lands over which the new road is laid out at Keizer Hill in the parish of Christ Church between Highway

U and Enterprise Road in that parish are dedicated for the use of the public as a roadway and sidewalk.
