**BARBADOS****ORDERS-IN-COUNCIL (AMENDMENT AND REVOCATION)
1970-46**

An Act to provide for the amendment or revocation of Orders-in-Council.

[Commencement: 31st December, 1970]

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Orders-in-Council (Amendment and Revocation) Act.

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this Act—
“Order-in-Council” means an Order-in-Council made under a United Kingdom Act;
“Order-in-Council to which this Act applies” means an Order-in-Council which applies, or applies the provisions of any United Kingdom Act with or without modification, to Barbados, but excludes—
 - (a) the Barbados Independence Order, 1966, and the Schedule thereto;
 - (b) any Order-in-Council which applies to Barbados by virtue of any Act of the Parliament of Barbados.

Amendment or revocation of Orders-in-Council by the Prime Minister

3.(1) The Prime Minister may by order amend or revoke any Order-in-Council to which this Act applies.

(2) An order made under subsection (1) may contain such consequential, supplemental or ancillary provisions as are necessary and expedient for giving due effect to the order, and accordingly an order which amends an Order-in-Council to which this Act applies may, where it appears to the Prime Minister necessary or expedient to do so, modify any provision of a United Kingdom Act which has been applied to Barbados by that Order-in-Council.

(3) An order made under subsection (1) shall be subject to negative resolution.
