**BARBADOS****GRANTS-IN-AID (CHURCHES)
1891-9**

An Act to consolidate and amend the Acts of this Island relating to making grants in aid to certain Churches.

[Commencement: 15th April, 1891]

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Grants-in-Aid (Churches) Act.

Grant of \$1,920 per annum to Moravian Mission

2. There shall be paid monthly to the Superintendent of the Church of the United Brethren, commonly called the Moravians, established in this Island, the annual sum of one thousand nine hundred and twenty dollars, being four hundred and eighty dollars to each of the four established missionary stations.

Grant of \$3,360 per annum for uses of Wesleyan Mission

3. There shall be paid monthly to the Superintendent of the Wesleyan Mission in this Island an annual sum of three thousand three hundred and sixty dollars for the uses of the Mission.

Grant of stipend of \$240 per annum to Minister of Roman Catholic Church

4. There shall be paid monthly to the Minister of the Roman Catholic Church in this Island an annual sum of two hundred and forty dollars.

Sums to be charged on Consolidated Fund

5. All sums granted by this Act shall be charged upon the Consolidated Fund.
